



Edmonton Catholic Schools (ECSD) is committed to gathering valuable stakeholder input and hosted an engagement session on October 24th inviting our Community of School Councils (COSC) with an opportunity to share their feedback. We thank our School Councils and Principals for participating in this engagement session to assist the Board and Division in establishing priorities for the new Division Plan for Continuous Growth 2023-2026.

The Alberta School Boards Association (ASBA) held its Fall General Meeting in Edmonton on November 20-22. It was an opportunity for our Board to gather with members from school boards across the province to pass resolutions pertaining to education and to attend sessions that provided excellent professional growth opportunities. The program included an event where our Board was able to meet with our local MLAs to dialogue about issues and priorities facing Alberta's school boards.

There is also so much happening in regard to innovation which is essential to the continu-



ing success of our Division. ECSD has a rich history and a proven track record in developing innovative ways to support the work of schools in creating new and exciting opportunities for students.

The Capstone Personalized Education Portfolio Program (C-PEPP) is one such opportunity available to ESCD students which creates an alternate pathway for admission to Canadian universities. ECSD is one of three pilot school divisions in Canada. This pilot allows students to pursue a more personalized and authentic learning journey that enables them to have a well-rounded portfolio of experiences and gain them access to postsecondary opportunities at the University of Alberta.

The Centre for Global Education (CGE) also develops and delivers virtual collaborative learning projects that engage and empower K-12 students as global citizens. CGE is now housed within ECSD's central office, and in collaboration with our Learning Services Department, is providing support to schools across Alberta though a wide array of curricular and special interest topics and opportunities. We are so proud of




the outstanding and innovative leadership being shown by staff within our Division.


