Common Gardening Mistakes

Choosing Plants That are not Suitable to our Climate

I can't stress this enough - Research your plants ahead of time, or at least read the label and check what Zone they are suitable for. Too often have I come across plant species in the big box stores that have little to no chance of surviving our climate. Depending on who you ask, Edmonton is somewhere between Zone 3 and 4. If you're looking to adventure higher than a zone 3 it's important to do your research and prepare to make special accommodations to protect over winter.

Placing plants in an Unsuitable Location

Figuring out what "Full Sun to Partial Shade" or "Part Shade to Full Shade" means can sometimes be tricky. Here are some basic guidelines of sunshine per day:

Full Sun – 6 hours +; Part Sun – 3-6 hours (will tolerate afternoon sun); Part Shade - 3-6 (will not tolerate afternoon sun); Full Shade -3 hours or less

There are various measuring devices available for purchase that can help you determine the sunlight you receive in any particular area but the cheapest and probably most effective is simple observation. Every 30 minutes of so, go out and check the area you want to measure and take note of how long the sun sticks around. It may take several days or even a week to determine an average.

Improper Watering

For fruit and veggies that may be more vulnerable to powdery mildew and other fungal

diseases it is recommended to water at the base and not overhead onto the leaves. Especially if the weather is cool and cloudy.

The best time of day to water is first thing in the morning. This will allow for maximum absorption with the least amount of stress. During the scorching heat of mid-afternoon, it may be tempting to water your garden but at this time of day, water evaporates quickly, so less chance of it actually soaking into the root zone. Water droplets on leaves under the hot sun can also burn.

A common watering mistake is watering too often and too shallow. Shallow watering is ineffective because not enough water reaches the root zone, most evaporates at the surface. Watering less frequently but deeply (and slowly so the soil has a chance to absorb) is far better.

Overfertilizing

More fertilizer does not equate to better growing plants. Over fertilizing can burn foliage and roots. Because fertilizers contain nitrogen salts (and salt draws out moisture) the effects of fertilizer burn will be noticeable by yellowing/brown leaves and root damage. Plants that suffer from fertilizer burn are also more susceptible to insects and disease. Select the right type of fertilizer for your plants and follow the recommended frequency of application.
