

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

Itching to get out and garden?

Now that our days are slowly beginning to rise above 0°C and our days are getting longer, we are being drawn outdoors. After a long winter and a spring that seemingly took forever to smarten up, we are eager to get going and get our garden started!

But where do we start? The best place to start, is always at the beginning! The beginning of the gardening season should always include a good clean. Restoration and repair will undoubtedly lead to a healthier and more appealing garden.

One thing to consider before beginning your big spring clean — Beneficial insects! Many types of beneficial insects such as lady bugs and pollinators (bees and butterflies) spend their winter dormant in old plant material such as dead leaves, grass, mulch, etc. Before raking up those leaves or tilling up that garden patch, you may want to consider holding off. As a rule, waiting until the temperature rises to around 10°C, for 10 days straight will

ensure that our beneficial critter friends have the chance to emerge from their slumber! This is a win-win!

Since we've tackled spring clean-up, let's turn our attention to our garden. In particular, the soil! Depending on how waterlogged

and depleted your garden area was over winter, your soil may need re-amending. Nutrients and materials such as mulch, microorganisms and organics may need replenishing. Top dressing your garden with a healthy compost/manure and your first application of mulch is a good first step to ensuring

your garden areas are ready to go this gardening season!

Now that your garden areas are prepared you can begin planting (some) vegetable seeds. Spinach, edible peas and sweet peas can be sown directly into the ground around April 20th.
