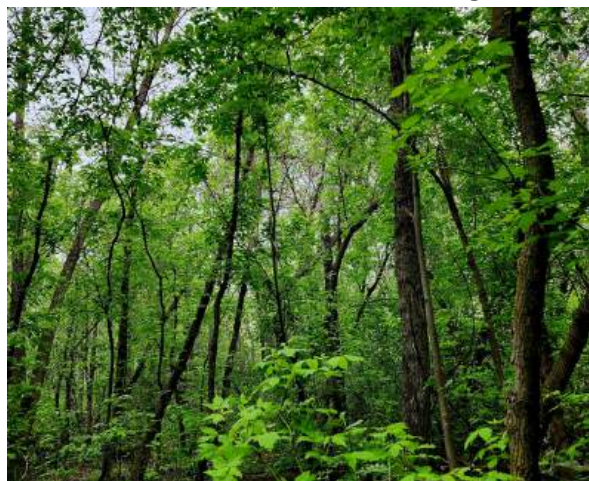

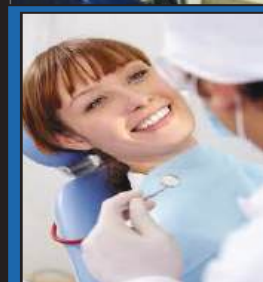

The past few months have been a time for meaningful recognition across Edmonton Catholic Schools. The Board of Trustees has had the privilege of acknowledging the dedication and accomplishments that strengthen our Division and reflect our shared Catholic mission.

A recent highlight was the annual Board of Trustees Retirement Gala, where we recognized staff members who have faithfully served our schools and sites and are now entering retirement. This cherished event offers the opportunity to personally thank those whose steady presence, deep care, and quiet faith have shaped our Division in lasting ways. Though they may no longer walk the halls, their legacy lives on in classrooms, colleagues, and the countless lives they've touched.

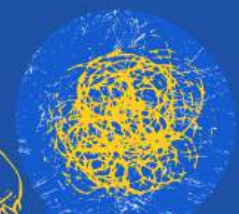
