You should also know that your elected government officials heard what your advocates had to say, and reiterated a commitment to working with community leagues to work together to address these issues.

SECLA fits into this equation in its role as bringing the southeast communities together on common issues, and facilitating opportunities for further civic engagement. SECLA has plans to help community leagues help



each other. Some leagues within the southeast are very fortunate to have a strong force of volunteers and resources at their disposal, and others are less fortunate and have had to discontinue services as a result. As an organisation, SECLA hopes to facilitate the pooling of resources and knowledge to alleviate some of these gaps, but it takes a village.

SECLA is just one part

of the solution, city administration and the EFCL another. What is really needed is community members to reach out to their community leagues to see how they can get involved. Getting involved does not have to mean you are dedicating hours a week to run programs at your league, and you do not necessarily have to attend meetings every month. It can be as simple as letting your community league know that you

are there and available to help in whatever limited capacity you can, however frequently this can be managed. This could be as little as helping out with setting up an event at vour community hall, or helping with admin work. We have a rich array of residents in our communities with all manner of life experience that could be pooled for the greater community good. Besides, this is a great way to get to know your neighbours, and we could all use a little more community in our life.





Understanding **Tuberculosis**

Alberta Health Services is bringing awareness to World Tuberculosis Day on March 24. Learning about this contagious infection can support better health for all Albertans.

What is Tuberculosis? Tuberculosis (TB) is an infection caused by slowgrowing bacteria. It commonly affects the lungs. but can also affect the kidneys, brain or spine. It is preventable and can be cured by treatment with antibiotics.

Like many airborne illnesses. TB is contagious and spreads when a person who has active TB breathes out air that has the TB bacteria in it. An infected person releases even more bacteria through laughing, coughing, or sneezing.

TB bacterium grows best in areas of the body that have lots of blood and oxygen. That's why it is most often found in the lungs.
